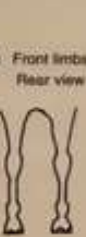

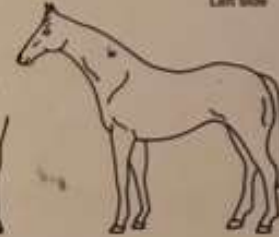

In the event the client and/or third parties are of the opinion that the health of the horse at the time of the present examination does not correspond to that which is stated in the examination report, those parties must report this to the veterinary surgeon without delay and in writing (for example, together with the appropriate certified, dated copies of the report of every sign of illness against the examining veterinarian, under the veterinarian's jurisdiction, and in fact the only liable compensation, after the veterinarian's providing a copy of this report to the examination veterinarian and the veterinarian practice.  
7. The date of the statements shall apply exclusively to the date stated during the performance of the examination, and the completion of the examination report, and the Court of the Netherlands shall retain the jurisdiction to hear these claims.  
8. In the event of differing interpretations between the Dutch and English text of these conditions, the version of the Dutch text shall be decisive.
