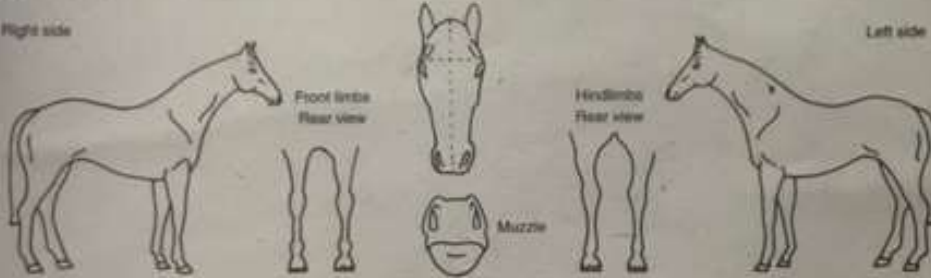

1. The examining veterinary surgeon neither guarantees, nor is he held liable for the in- or damage caused as a result of the performance of the examination or as a result of negligence or professional or other responsibility of the client, unless it has been established that the cause of damage or loss is related to negligence to the part of the examining veterinary surgeon.
 2. The client shall have the sole right to make any further use of the part of the examining veterinary surgeon and of information obtained as described under 1. above. Further, also that the client shall not be entitled to have any claim or responsibility for damages arising from the examination.
 3. Legally, such as stated in or from the present contract to the veterinary surgeon professional liability insurance is applicable in the case of the examination. Details of the coverage in the form of policy documents to the insurance may be obtained at the veterinary practice premises, and copies of these may be obtained at the request from the veterinary practice at no charge.
 4. The present contract is the examination report and also applies to the parts that shall not be kept by the client, or where it is kept by the client.
 5. If the client upon whom the veterinarian has performed is not the owner of the horse, the client is solely responsible for having obtained the written consent of all persons having the authority to give the consent, and the client shall not be held responsible for the veterinary surgeon if consent is not given to the horse being held or otherwise that such consent was not given.
 6. If the client has not written his/her name on the report and the health of the horse at the time of the present examination does not correspond to that which is stated in the examination report, then the client shall report this to the veterinary surgeon within three days of writing the examination report after the practice premises, under penalty of the having of every claim of action against the examining veterinarian and/or the veterinarian practice, and to read the policy with its conditions, which also includes provisions providing a copy of the report to the examination veterinarian and by the veterinarian practice.
 7. The laws of the Netherlands shall apply, particularly in any dispute arising from the performance of the examination under the conditions of the examination report, and the Court of the Netherlands shall have sole jurisdiction in any dispute arising.
 8. In the event of differing interpretations between the Dutch and English text of these conditions, the version in the Dutch text shall be decisive.
