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**Diagnose** : Vetcheck

**Anamnese** : Vetting.

**Klinisch** : Only the abnormalities or normal anatomical variations will be noted.  
Intended use: dressage horse.  
Actual level: 5Y old

Clinical examination:  
Good general condition, alert, shod.  
No significant abnormalities on inspection and palpation.

Orthopaedic examination:  
- No lameness when walking and trotting on a straight line on a hard surface.  
- No lameness when trotting on a circle on hard and soft surfaces.  
- Canter: ok, no respiratory noises  
- Flexion test distal limb fronts: negative, no lameness.  
- Flexion test of fetlocks, hocks and stifles: negative, no lameness.  
- Turning at stance and reversing: normal movements.

Examination of the eyes:  
No significant abnormalities seen.

Radiographical examination (views):  
- front feet: LM, DPr--PDiO  
- hocks: LM, DL-PIMO and DM-PILO  
- stifles: LM, caud-cran  
- hind + front fetlocks: LM, DP

Radiographical findings:  
LF foot: elongation flexor cortex navicular bone. Mild irregular lining dorsal aspect proximal interphalangeal joint.  
RF foot: no significant bony abnormalities radiographically visible.  
L hock: no significant bony abnormalities radiographically visible.  
R hock: mild irregular lining dorsal aspect distal tarsal bones.  
L stifle: no significant bony abnormalities radiographically visible.

R stifle: no significant bony abnormalities radiographically visible.  
LH fetlock: no significant bony abnormalities radiographically visible.  
RH fetlock: no significant bony abnormalities radiographically visible.  
LF fetlock: no significant bony abnormalities radiographically visible.  
RF fetlock: no significant bony abnormalities radiographically visible.

PS:

The horse is easy to examine.

During the examination, there were no indications of stereotypical behaviour (for example: windsucking).

Blood sample for doping-analysis: not requested, sample stored for 3 months.

Blood sample for general screening: not requested.

**Besluit** : Based on the examination of today 08/09/22 the above mentioned horse Be Minion van 't durp receives a  $\pm$  normal risk for purchase as a sportshorse.
