



Prepurchase examination report

On July 1st 2020, undersigning veterinarian Bert Seys performed a prepurchase examination on the horse "Haskal, chip nr: 528210002841340".

Adspection and palpation:

Scar at the medial heelbulb of the left hind limb. Thrush of the left front frog
The horse is shod with normal shoes.
Right front slightly toe out conformation

Auscultation of heart and lungs

Heart in rest: no significant findings

Heart after 10 minutes trot and canter: no significant findings, normal recovery time

Lungs in rest: no significant findings

Lungs after 10 min trot and canter: no significant findings, normal recovery time

Walk on a straight line: No significant findings

Trot on a straight line no significant findings

Lunging on soft surface No significant findings

Lunging on a hard surface no significant findings

Flexion tests
Left front negative
Right front negative
Left hind negative
Right hind negative

Canter

Occasional crosscantering on both hands. Mild in-and expirational breathing sounds

The horse was not examined under tack.

No signs of neurologic disease.

Examination of the eyes: no significant findings

Endoscopic examnition:

Normal mobility of the arythenoid and the vocal cords. Mild folliculitis in the throat.

Radiographic examination:

Bone fragment at the plantar aspect of the left hind fetlock Very mild spur on the medial aspect the tibial plateau of the left and right hind stifle

Mild depression in the distal border of the left front navicular bone.

Conclusion:

Based on the findings of the examination performed on July 1st 2020, the horse is suitable for a carreer as a showjumping horse.

Advice to remove the fragment in the left hind fetlock
